In re: Termination of AGS Law

ORDER TERMINATING AUTHORIZATION TO PRACTICE LAW


Based upon the Utah Supreme Court's plenary and constitutionally granted authority to regulate the practice of law in Utah, and the tenets of Standing Order 15, the Utah Supreme Court orders that AGS's authorization to practice law within the regulatory sandbox is terminated.

The Court has reviewed the recommendation of the Office of Legal Services Innovation assessing AGS's request to withdraw from the Sandbox and cease offering all Sandbox authorized services. AGS was authorized to practice law within the sandbox pursuant to a court order dated August 16, 2022.

Considering the Court's responsibility to the public to effectively regulate the practice of law in Utah and in keeping with the tenets of Standing Order 15, the Court now orders as follows:

AGS's Authorization, granted August 16, 2022, is hereby terminated.
