In re: Termination of Utah Legal Advocates

ORDER TERMINATING AUTHORIZATION TO PRACTICE LAW

Based upon the Utah Supreme Court's plenary and constitutionally granted authority to regulate the practice of law in Utah, and the tenets of Standing Order 15, the Utah Supreme Court orders that Utah Legal Advocates's authorization is terminated.

The Court has reviewed the recommendation of the Office of Legal Services Innovation certifying that Utah Legal Advocates has requested to withdraw from the Sandbox and cease offering all Sandbox authorized services.

In light of the Court's responsibility to the public to effectively regulate the practice of law in Utah and in keeping with the tenets of Standing Order 15, the Court now orders as follows:

Utah Legal Advocates' Authorization granted September 23, 2021 is hereby terminated.
